TLG Volunteer Portfolio Guidelines

A portfolio offers TLG Volunteers a means of storing, organizing and sharing materials and information related to their teaching in a way which encourages reflection and professional development. A portfolio can be used to store material a teacher and their learners produce. This should include:

- The TLG Volunteer's statement of the teaching philosophy;
- Class profiles;
- Lesson materials:
- Teaching methods;
- Student assessment;
- Lesson plans;
- Examples of learners' work;
- Learners' and peer feedback;
- Self-reflections and self-evaluation on their teaching;
- Personal goals for improving teaching and enhancing skills.

To be eligible to submit the portfolio you must work at Georgian public school in grade 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and/or 6 for at least 3 consecutive months during September 15th 2012 through June 15th 2013.

Please format your portfolio as it should be the PDF format and send it as an attachment to tlginbox@tlg.gov.ge by the 20th of June, 2013. The subject line should read - "TLG Volunteer Portfolio for Your Name".

Evaluation of the Portfolios will take place starting June 21st 2013 (please see the evaluation rubrics); the portfolios with the highest scores will be posted on the TLG website.

Additionally, teachers applying for a new position can make use of a teacher portfolio as expanded Curriculum Vitae to showcase their achievements, experience and beliefs to prospective employers.

Follow the above mentioned instructions and evaluation rubric for content ideas and requirements.
